

Minutes of the Notice No.: 2026/P/52

A meeting of the Standing Committee of the Academic Council was held on February 16, 2026, 2 pm at Saradananda Conference Hall. The Chairperson, Standing Committee of the Academic Council, Swami Mahaprajnananda (Principal maharaj), extended a warm welcome to all members of the IQAC. The items of the agenda were taken up and deliberated upon one by one.

1. Confirmation of Proceedings of the previous meeting: Proceedings of the last meeting were accepted.

2. Publication of results for the odd semesters: Swami Shanteshananda, the Joint Controller of Examinations, read out the results of each department, mentioning number of examinees, number of students with first division, name of the student who scored highest marks, failed candidates etc. The Head/representative of each department then analyzed the result and stated his observation.

The observation, comments and remarks regarding the result voiced by the Head of the departments/representatives were insightful. All of the HoDs expressed overall satisfaction to their departmental results. They pointed progress and weakness of their departmental students. However, a handful of students failed in their minor papers. A few students were detained for malpractices in the examination Hall. Supplementary examinations would be conducted shortly for those who could not qualify the exam.

It was noted that many students of Computer Science Major could not qualify in the Mathematics Minor paper. Prof. Subhankar Roy, HoD of Mathematics pointed that all students should not be offered Mathematics as minor in 1st Semester indiscriminately. Principal Maharaj advised to conduct a screening test on Mathematics before admitting students in Mathematics minor in the first semester.


Name of a few students were noted who create nuisance in the hostel. Feedback of hostel superintendent maharajas for them along with students found adopting malpractices inside examination hall were noted. Guardians of those students would be called for reporting and required measures.

Issue of absence of students in the class was noted.

Dr. Diptendu Sarkar, HoD of Microbiology expressed his concern on examinees cheating in the hall using mobile phones. It was decided that considering views of the departments, college authority would notify to restrain students to keep their mobile phones with them on the date of examinations.

3. Miscellaneous: All the members were requested to intimate students about FRAME, a nonprofit initiative led by Science and Engineering PhD students, Postdoctoral researchers and Academicians, to apply for their internship grants.

It was decided that Meeting of the NEP implementation Committee would be convened in the month of March, 2026 to formulate 8th Sem project modalities for B.Sc. (H) with research degree.
