

I. Publication of UG 2nd, UG 4th & PG 2nd Semester Results: Swami Shanteshananda, the Joint Controller of Examinations, read out the results of each department, mentioning number of examinees, number of students with first division, name of the student who scored highest marks, failed candidates etc. The Head/representative of each department then analyzed the result and stated his observation.

The observation, comments and remarks regarding the result voiced by the Head of the departments/representatives were insightful. All of the HoDs expressed overall satisfaction to their departmental results. However, it was observed that while a few students improved a lot, some could perform better.

It was observed that attendance of many 1st sem students was poor, especially in their minor subjects. In reply to Issues of granting leave without informing HoD, Principal Maharaj said that attendance would be monitored and sanctioned online with intimation to all stakeholders. Principal Maharaj requested faculty members to orient new students regarding importance of regular attendance and inform him or vice Principal Br. Tattwachaitanya Maharaj, in case of prolonged absence of any student. Proposals of guardians' call, deduction of more marks, disciplinary action, notifying the name of the students as punishment for absence etc. were proposed. Principal Maharaj proposed to increase weightage on attendance from existing 5 marks to 10 marks after discussion with Academic Council members. Dr. Diptendu Sarkar expressed his worries that it would dilute the quality of students and all the members agreed to this.

In reply to a question on exit of UG students after completion of three years under NEP 2020, Principal Maharaj said that after taking exit from the program one would not be granted permission to take readmission to complete 4 year undergraduate course from Vidyamandira. Moreover, as official rules and regulations from national institutions or universities for admission to post-graduation program-2026 are yet to be published, we have to wait to advice students in this regard.

II. Admission PG, 2025: Principal Maharaj said that number of applications received for admission to PG program, 2025 till date is ninety while number of seats is also ninety. The details are as follows: Beng-16, Sankrit-9, Philosophy-5, Computer Sc.-5, Mathamatics-8, History-17 and Industrial Chemistry-30.

III. Disciplinary issues: A few students were detained for malpractices in the examination Hall. Supplementary examinations would be conducted shortly for those who could not qualify the exam.

IV. Integrated PG Program: In continuation of a previous discussion with HoD, Microbiology regarding introduction of PG course in the department of Microbiology, Principal Maharaj said that according to Inspector of Colleges, CU, our existing 2 years PG courses are affiliated to be converted into 4 year integrated PG course. Vice Principal Br. Tattwachaitanya Maharaj proposed to convert two year PG program into one year PG from 2027-28 with seat reservation for students of Vidyamandira without integrating PG with 4 year UG. In response to a proposal from Dr. Tamoghna Mandal to introduce PG Program in subjects like Economics in collaboration with Presidency University, Vice Principal Br. Tattwachaitanya Maharaj cited some administrative constraints and the proposal could not be accepted. Dr. Indrashis Banerjee proposed to seek prior permission from UGC in this regard. In reply to a query from Dr. Diptendu Sarkar regarding his proposal to introduce PG in Microbiology, Principal Maharaj said that the proposal needs more discussion. After necessary discussion with other stakeholders including GB and standing Committee members and approval, department of Microbiology can introduce integrated PG program from 2027-28.

V. Miscellaneous: one student has requested to change his Major subject, Principal Maharaj will inform respective departments regarding this. Dr. Prithwiraj Biswas requested to prepare Attendance Register for MDC course at an earliest.
