

**Meeting of the IQAC held on July 14, 2025, 2:00 pm at Saradananda Conference Hall

Minutes of the Notice No.: 2025/P/236 Date: 12.7.2025

A meeting of the IQAC was held on July 14, 2025, 2 pm at Saradananda Conference Hall. The Chairperson, IQAC, Swami Mahaprajnananda (Principal maharaj), extended a warm welcome to all members of the IQAC. The items of the agenda were taken up and deliberated upon one by one.

1. Confirmation of Proceedings of the previous meeting: Proceedings of the last meeting held on June 13, 2025 (Vide notice no. 2025/P/48A dated 05.02.2025) were read aloud by the IQAC coordinator, issues discussed, highlighted and accepted.

2. Assessment and mapping of the course outcomes of UG 2nd, UG 4th & PG 2nd Semesters: Swami Shanteshananda, the Joint Controller of Examinations, read out the results of each department, mentioning number of examinees, number of students with first division, name of the student who scored highest marks, failed candidates etc. The Head/representative of each department then analyzed the result and stated his observation.

The observation, comments and remarks regarding the result voiced by the Head of the departments/representatives were insightful. All of the HoDs expressed overall satisfaction to their departmental results. However, it was observed that while a few students improved a lot, some could perform better. A few students were detained for malpractices in the examination Hall. Supplementary examinations would be conducted shortly for those who could not qualify the exam.

It was observed that attendance of many 1st sem students was poor, especially in their minor subjects. In reply to an issues of granting leave without informing HoD, principal maharaj said that attendance would be monitored and sanctioned online with intimation all stakeholders. Principal maharaj requested faculty members to aware new students regarding importance of attendance and inform principal or vice Principal maharaj in case of prolonged absence. Proposals of guardians' call increase in penalty marks, disciplinary action, notifying the name of the students as punishment etc. were proposed. Principal maharaj proposed to increase weightage on attendance from existing 5 marks to 10 marks after discussion with Academic Council. Dr. Diptendu Sarkar expressed his worries that it would dilute the quality and all the members agreed to this.

In reply to a question on exit of UG students after completion of 3 year under NEP, principal maharaj said that after taking exit from the program one would not be granted permission to take readmission to complete 4 year undergraduate course from Vidyamandira. Moreover, as official rules and regulations from national institutions or universities for admission to post-graduation program-2026 yet to be available, we have to wait to advice students in this regard.

3. Summer Training Program:

Summer training program ended successfully.

4. Integrated PG Program

In continuation of a discussion with HoD, Microbiology regarding Introduction of PG course in the department of Microbiology, principal maharaj said that according to Inspector of Colleges, CU, existing 2 years PG courses are affiliated to be converted into 4 year integrated PG course. Vice principal maharaj proposed to introduce 1 year PG program from 2027-28 without integrating PG

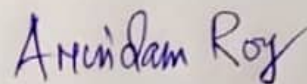
with 4 year UG with provision for direct admission for Vidyamandira students to PG. Dr. Indrashis Banerjee proposed to seek prior permission from UGC in this regard. In reply to a query from Dr. Diptendu Sarkar, principal maharaj said that after necessary approval, department of Microbiology can introduce integrated PG program from 2027-28.

5. Any other matter:

Principal maharaj said that one student has submitted prayer to change his minor. He will inform concerned department regarding it. Maharaj said that number of applications for admission to PG till date is ninety while number of seats is also ninety.
